On Tuesday 3 March, the History and Geography department are holding a joint **'Humanities Parent Information and Consultation Evening'** for all Year 11 students and parents/carers. You should have already received our 'Save the Date' text message before half term; this letter provides specific details of the event; how to book onto the key presentations; speak to your child's teacher and take advantage of the wealth of revision materials available.

The **'Humanities Parent Information and Consultation Evening'** has been scheduled to coincide with the upcoming Y11 mock examinations which will be the final time students are assessed before they sit their public examinations in the summer. The evening focusses solely on the Humanities and will provide parents/carers with information about how to best support your child in their preparation for the History and/or Geography examination papers. Both subjects have demanding and academically rigorous examinations and the key skills, knowledge and effective revision techniques will be covered on the evening.

This is a really important event and all parents/carers will be sent a further text message which will allow you to book onto the presentation of your choice using 'Event Brite'. The Outwood Grange Academies Trust Senior Director, Kate Wilson, and her director team will offer two presentation slots for both History and Geography which can be booked via the Event Brite service (parents/carers need only to book onto one slot).

- History presentation option 2: 6.30 pm

Teaching staff will be available in the Academy Restaurant between 5.00-7.00 pm to hold subject consultations with parents and give further advice at their dedicated Revision Stalls. Refreshments will be available throughout the evening in the Restaurant area and parking is available on the Academy site.
