Y10 Face to Face Teaching Sessions – W/C 6th July 2020

Dear Parent/Carer,

It was fantastic to be able to invite more staff and students back on site in the last couple of weeks for Academic Tutoring and taught lessons. To build on this success further, we are in a position to offer students more face to face, one hour teaching sessions for all Y10 students.

Students will be taught two, one hour lessons by their academic tutor or a subject specialist in their 'bubble' on two different days. One lesson will be in their bubble of 12 in the Conference Theatre and the other lesson will be in a group of 6 students from the same bubble in their classroom. The rooms have been configured to ensure all students and the teacher are adhering to social distancing guidelines.

Students will be provided with paper at their desk but will need to bring their own writing pen with them. In putting these measures in place, we will be adhering to all the current guidance and staff and students will only have direct or indirect contact with 12 people.

Students will follow the same risk management procedures as before sanitising their hands on entry and exit from the Academy. Each room will be cleaned when students leave to ensure a safe environment for both students and staff members.

It is important that students only come in for these sessions at the time that has been arranged. To keep us all safe, they should not come to school or leave school with other friends and follow all the social distancing guidelines both in school and out in the community. If all our protective measures are followed carefully and the guidance remains the same, we are hopeful that we will be able to continue this provision until the end of the academic year.
