

Attendance quick reference guide for parents/carers during Covid-19

What to do if...	Action	Return to school when...
My child has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Do not come to school ❖ Contact school daily ❖ Self Isolate ❖ Get a test ❖ Contact school as soon as you get the test result back 	The test comes back negative OR 10 days after the onset of the illness.
My child tests positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Do not come to school ❖ Self Isolate for at least 10 days after onset of illness. ❖ Inform school immediately regarding result of test 	They can return (after 10 days) even if they still have a cough or loss of smell/taste as these symptoms can last for several weeks after the infection has gone.
Someone in my house has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Do not come to school ❖ Self Isolate ❖ Contact school daily. ❖ Household member to get a test ❖ Inform school immediately of the test result 	The household member test result is negative.
Someone in my household has tested positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Do not come to school ❖ Self Isolate for 14 days from when the member of their household first had symptoms. 	The child has completed 14 days of self isolation.
NHS Test and Trace has identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms or a confirmed case of coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Do not come to school ❖ Self Isolate for 14 days 	The child has completed 14 days of self isolation.
My child has travelled and has to self isolate as part of the quarantine period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Do not come to school ❖ Self Isolate for 14 days ❖ Avoid taking holidays in term time, ❖ Consider quarantine requirements when booking future holidays. 	The 14 day quarantine period has been completed.
We have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Do not come to school ❖ Access online learning as instructed by the school. ❖ Shield 	Restrictions are lifted
